## Happy Valentine's Day!

What a wonderful day to say "thank you" to all of you who have contributed to Sylvia's Children ... sponsors, Christmas in July, food bank, Christmas party ... we have been able to continue our support of the school and what a joy it is to be able to say ... they are back in school as of January 10 of this year!

The *Republic of Ugandan Education Service Commission* has automatically moved every primary school child up one grade, increased their three terms in the year from 12 weeks to fourteen weeks, and streamlined the education in anticipation of the children being able to make up for the students' lost time by the end of 2023 to be back to normal.

Statistically: We have 1,000 children in primary school, 25% of whom are orphans. 87 orphans are in high school and 57 orphans are in college and/or technical school. Currently, 66 of our orphans have graduated from college and are teachers, nurses, plumbers, electricians, beauticians, etc.

Every year in mid-June, we host a birthday party for the orphans of the school. Because they don't know exactly when they were born, we celebrate everyone's birthday with a cake and meat sauce over rice and a soda (something that is a huge treat). The cost is \$3,500 (the most expensive being the \$500 for the cow so we may offer the meat sauce with the meal). For the vegetarians, we serve peanut sauce--which my son, Tony, LOVES!

## Orphan Sponsorship

As is always on our minds, with 25% of our children being orphans, we are continually seeking sponsors for individual students. For a child in primary school, a sponsorship costs \$360 a year which covers food, healthcare, lodging, clothing, and education. For a high school student, it goes up a little to \$500 a year for all the same expenses. When you think that we already have 66 orphans who are now self-reliant, thanks to our angel sponsors and expect another 57 in the next two years, it is easy to see that a sponsor is truly making a difference by investing in another human's life and making it possible for them to be self-reliant, thereby helping their families.
